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- The data shows all environmental limits are being complied with in the bay
- Despite some noticeable fluctuations, no response levels were triggered
- Winds contributed to fluctuations at the mouth of the Yarra River (conformance monitoring location for the protection of migratory fish). There was an approximate 14-hour data gap over 21-22 October. Data immediately after this period showed turbidity levels decreased. Throughout this period, notably there was no dredging activity with a major dredge vessel (i.e. Trailing Suction Hopper Dredge).
