









Interpretation of Weekly Turbidity Monitoring Results, released 25 February 2009

- The data shows low turbidity (i.e. below response levels and environmental limits) across all conformance monitoring sites.
- PoMC notified agencies of a turbidity data gap over 16-17 February which affected the calculation of three six-hourly readings at Rye Jetty. This was due to algae wrapped around both probe sensors. A buoy replacement was completed, and turbidity levels were found to be consistent with background levels. No dredging occurred in the south of the Bay during this period.
