









Interpretation of Weekly Turbidity Monitoring results, released 22 April 2009

- For the period 13-20 April, the report shows low turbidity across all conformance monitoring sites. No environmental limits or response levels were reached
- A wind storm over April 15-16 saw elevated turbidity at two monitoring sites:
 - Capel Sound (April 16) due to a combination of elevated metocean conditions from storm and dredging activity within South Channel
 - Hobsons Bay Mud (April 15) due to elevated metocean conditions, from strong and gusty Westerly winds.
