









## Interpretation of weekly turbidity monitoring results, released 29 April 2009

- For the period 20-27 April, the report shows low turbidity across all conformance monitoring sites, with the exception of SE DMG.
- A storm event consisting of very strong and extended winds (with gusts in excess of 113km/h) was experienced in Melbourne. In light of the conditions, dredging activities were suspended in the southern channel from 9.30am on Sunday 26 April to 6.45am the following day. Exceedances of the environmental limit were recorded south of SE DMG. Conditions subsequently eased and turbidity levels returned to normal.
