









Interpretation of weekly turbidity monitoring results, released 29 July 2009

- Metocean conditions were dominated by strong northerly winds early in the week. A southerly change saw 14mm rainfall on 23 July, with a return to strong northerly winds for the remainder of the week.
- Increases in turbidity can be seen at Capel Sound and SE DMG due to elevated metocean conditions. The turbidity levels were below the environmental limits and no response levels were reached.
